

# Allowable File Types for the Files Tab

Below is a list of allowed file extensions/types that can be uploaded to the Files tab. **These same file types also apply for file uploads on Forms.** Any file types not included in this list should trigger a file type error in the upload modal.

**Highlighted file types count as Photos**, and when uploaded in Forms or other areas of the app will be treated as Photos and appear in the Photos tab rather than the Files tab. The link cards for these in the upload modal should be displayed with a photo thumbnail rather than a material icon.

Depending on the file type, different icons should be shown in the upload modal and on the files tab to represent file type. All file types should have the generic file icon except those specifically called out below.
